Scope of Committee

Practice before the U.S. International Trade Commission ("ITC") and enforcement of ITC exclusion orders by the Department of Homeland Security ("DHS") in patent, trademark, gray market, copyright and related matters and appeals thereof to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit ("CAFC") and the U.S. Court of International Trade ("CIT") pursuant to Section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. 1337; pending or proposed legislation relating to the ITC and DHS; and the administration of the ITC and the DHS as it relates to the enforcement of ITC remedial orders by DHS. The Committee studies and makes recommendations with respect to the rules and regulations of the ITC and DHS relating to matters before them relating to Section 337 and with respect to pending or proposed legislation regarding Section 337 and/or DHS enforcement of orders issued by the ITC.
