On this date, the undersigned issued the Initial Determination on the question of violation of section 337, with the following conclusions of law:

1. The Commission has personal jurisdiction over the parties, *in rem* jurisdiction over the accused products, and subject matter jurisdiction over the investigation.

2. The importation or sale requirement is satisfied.

3. It has been shown by a preponderance of the evidence that Samsung's accused

products literally infringe claims 1, 4, and 12 of United States Patent No. 5,493,335.

4. It has been shown by a preponderance of the evidence that Samsung's accused products literally infringe claims 15, and 23-27 of United States Patent No. 6,292,218.

5. It has not been shown that claim 1, or claim 4 of the '335 patent is invalid due to anticipation.

6. It has not been shown that claim 1, claim 4, or claim 12 of the '335 patent is invalid due to obviousness.

7. It has not been shown that claim 1 of the '335 patent is invalid due to obviousness-type double patenting.

8. It has not been shown that the asserted claims of the '218 patent are invalid due to failure to comply with the written description requirement of 35 U.S.C. § 112.

9. It has not been shown that the '218 patent is unenforceable.

10. The domestic industry requirement is satisfied with respect to the '335 patent and the '218 patent.

11. A violation of section 337 has occurred with respect to the '335 patent and the '218 patent.
