NOTICE REGARDING INITIAL DETERMINATION CONCERNING
COMPLAINANT'S MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RELIEF

(August 12, 2014)

On this date, I issued an Initial Determination concerning Complainant's motion for temporary relief in the above referenced litigation. As explained in the Initial Determination, the Complainant's motion for temporary relief was denied because Complainant did not show (1) a likelihood of success on the merits, (2) that it would suffer irreparable harm, (3) that the balance of hardships would favor Complainant, and (4) that the public interest would not be disserved if temporary relief is granted. A complete public version of the Initial Determination will be issued when all the parties have submitted their redactions and I have had an opportunity to review the redactions.

Notice of the initial determination is being served on the other agencies listed in 19 C.F.R. § 210.50(a)(2). Pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.66(d), "[t]hose agencies will be given 10 calendar days from the date of service of the notice to file comments on the initial determination."
