

NONRUBBER FOOTWEAR QUARTERLY STATISTICAL REPORT

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Washington, DC 20436**



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HIGHLIGHTS

U.S. production--Although the volume of nonrubber footwear production has remained fairly steady at around 41 million pairs per quarter over the last four quarters, production of 41.2 million pairs in the second quarter of 1992 represents a 10 percent increase from the corresponding period of 1991. The value of producers' shipments was also up -- by 9 percent -- from the second quarter in 1991, to \$839.4 million. The U.S. industry's share of consumption rose slightly over the first quarter of 1991, to 14 percent by quantity and 28 percent by value. Employment rose from 65,700 employees in the first quarter of 1992 to 66,600 in the second quarter. The unemployment rate in the quarter, at 17 percent, was lower than it was in the same period last year (17.8 percent), but was up from 11.4 percent in the first quarter of this year.

U.S. imports--Nonrubber footwear imports were down in the second quarter from the first quarter, but were up 5 percent over the comparable period in 1991, to 222.5 million pairs valued at \$1.97 billion.

The rise in imports from China, the leading import supplier, decelerated to 25 percent by volume and 39 percent by value. China's share of total U.S. imports expanded from 41 percent in the second quarter of 1991 to 48 percent in the second quarter of 1992. Brazil and Taiwan were the second and third leading volume suppliers, accounting for 11 percent and 10 percent of total imports, respectively. Imports from Taiwan and Korea continued to drop (by 29 and 31 percent, respectively), but those from Brazil grew 14 percent by volume.

Imports from Indonesia were up 47 percent by volume in the second quarter of 1992 over the corresponding period of 1991. Indonesia continued its growth as a footwear supplier, as Korean and other firms have maintained or increased their investment there, stimulated by increasing wages in other parts of Asia and by the persistent uncertainty over the future of China's most-favored-nation trade status with the United States. Although Indonesia's share in the second quarter of 1992 amounted to only 6.9 percent of total U.S. imports, this share surpassed the share provided by the entire European Community.
