SUMMARY: The Commission's notice published in the *Federal Register* on March 7, 2003 (68 F.R. 11143) contained a typographical error that incorrectly identified one of the HTS subheadings upon which the Commission will provide advice as to the probable economic effect on U.S. industries producing like or directly competitive articles and on consumers of the elimination of U.S. import duties for all beneficiary countries under the GSP. The Commission will provide advice for HTS subheading 7202.93.00; it will not provide advice for HTS subheading 7202.93.00 (pt.).
