This is to request approval for a survey in connection with strategic planning for the United States International Trade Commission ("the Commission") with respect to the effectiveness of exclusion orders issued by the Commission following investigations under section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. §1337). Enclosed are three copies of all the following items: form 83-I, supporting statement with attachments, the *Federal Register* notice entitled "Agency Form Submitted to OMB for Review," transmittal letter that will be included with the survey and two survey forms.

The Commission has decided to use surveys, which will be used only once, to gather important data that is not available from any other sources.

The enclosed surveys have been structured in such a manner to minimize the reporting burden on survey recipients. Moreover, the surveys were refined after a similar survey was conducted in 2000 which in turn was pretested with a sampling of prevailing complainants who obtained exclusion orders from the Commission.

We would greatly appreciate your processing the request by or before September 1, 2005. The surveys are tentatively scheduled to be mailed on or about September 6, 2005.
