2,7-Naphthalenedisulfonic acid, 5-[[[4-chloro-6-[[[3-[[[4-fluoro-6-(methylphenylamino)-1,3,5-triazin-2-yl]amino-1-hydroxy-3,6-disulfo-2-naphthalenyl]azo]-4-sulfophenyl],amino]-1,3,5-triazin-2-yl]amino]-4-hydroxy-3-[(1-sulfo-2-naphthalenyl)azo], sodium salt (CAS No. 155522-05-7) (Color Index Reactive red 270) (provided for in subheading 3204.16.30)

This synthetic organic dyestuff, known as Reactive red 270, is used to dye cotton fiber and fabric. This dye is imported from Switzerland.

³ The Commission may express an opinion on the HTS classification of a product to facilitate consideration of the bill. However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.
