2-(2,6-Difluorophenyl)-4-[4-(1,1-dimethylethyl)-2-ethoxyphenyl]-4,5-dihydrooxazole (Etoxazole) (CAS No. 153233-91-1) (provided for in subheading 2934.99.18)

Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:

The subject product, commonly known as Etoxazole, is a miticide in the diphenyl oxazoline class of insecticides. Miticides made from Etoxazole are intended for use with ornamental plants and some commercial crops such as cotton, pome fruit, and strawberries. Etoxazole is imported from Japan. There are no other known importers.

3 **SECTION 1. ETOXAZOLE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:
