The product, imported from France, is a hindered amine light stabilizer that is used as a heat and light stabilizer to improve the dyeability and UV stability of polyamides and polyesters and associated colorants.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.04.11 of the Har-
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
7 1,3-Benzenedicarboxamide, N, N'-Bis (2,2,6,6-
8 tetramethyl-4-piperidinyl)-) is amended by striking “12/
9 31/2006” and inserting “12/31/2008”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
