esters of reduced polymerized oxidized tetrafluoroethylene, 2-ethyl-1-hexanol-blocked, acetates (salts)  
(CAS No. 328389-90-8) (provided for in subheading 3907.20.00).

1 **SECTION 1. 1,2-PROPANEDIOL, 3-(DIETHYLAMINO)-, POLY-**  
 2 **MERS WITH 5-ISOCYANATO-1-**  
 3 **(ISOCYANATOMETHYL)-1,3,3,-**  
 4 **TRIMETHYLCYCLOHEXANE, PROPYLENE GLY-**  
 5 **COL AND REDUCED ME ESTERS OF REDUCED**  
 6 **POLYMD. OXIDIZED TETRAFLUORO-**  
 7 **ETHYLENE, 2-ETHYL-1-HEXANOL-BLOCKED,**  
 8 **ACETATES (SALTS).**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
 10 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
 11 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
 12 new heading:

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13 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
 14 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn  
 15 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
