**Nature of bill:** Temporary duty suspension through December 31, 2011.

Copoly(bis(4-amino-3-methylcyclohexyl)methane/dodecanedioic acid) (CAS No. 163800-66-6)  
(provided for in subheading 3908.10.00).

**Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:**

The subject product and its variants are specialty copolymers of nylon 12 and cyclic aliphatic diamines. Key characteristics of these particular products are transparency, heat and chemical resistance, and excellent fatigue behavior. These polyamides are used in a variety of molded and extruded applications, including filter bowls, eyeglass frames, tooth brushes, and cable sheathing. The product is imported from Switzerland.

<sup>4</sup> The Commission may express an opinion on the HTS classification of a product to facilitate consideration of the bill. However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.

The Commission staff recommends that the article description on page 1 of this report be used in the proposed new heading in order to provide a clarified IUPAC chemical nomenclature and to provide the correct HTS subheading reference.

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## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on Grilamid TR 90.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GRILAMID TR 90.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Cyclohexanamine, 4,41- methylenebis (2- methylecyclohexanamine) (CAS No. 163800-66-6) (provided for in subheading 3908.90.7000) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.
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1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn  
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day  
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
