 1. If you are a domestic producer of a like or directly competitive product, identify the product.
 2. Did you make the article in the current calendar year? (Yes/No) If “no,” when was the last time you produced it?
 3. Do you keep the product in inventory (Yes/No)
 4. Do you make the product only when you receive an order for it? (Yes/No)
 5. Do you have U.S. production capacity to make the product in commercial quantities? (Yes/No)
