

**NOTICE OF INITIAL DETERMINATION ON VIOLATION OF SECTION 337 AND
RECOMMENDED DETERMINATION ON REMEDY AND BOND**

(June 26, 2020)

On this date, and pursuant to the Notice of Investigation, 84 Fed. Reg. 29877 (June 25, 2019), I issued the final Initial Determination in this matter. 19 C.F.R. §§ 210.10(b), 210.42(a)(1)(i). As explained in that determination, I have determined that a violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act, as amended, has not been proved in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation, of certain light-emitting diode products, systems, and components thereof based on allegations of infringement of U.S. Patent No. 7,095,053 and U.S. Patent No. 7,528,421.
