
**NOTICE OF REMAND INITIAL DETERMINATION
ON VIOLATION OF SECTION 337**

On this date, and pursuant to the Notice of Investigation, 88 Fed. Reg. 30342 (May 11, 2023), 19 C.F.R. §§ 210.10(b), 210.42(a)(1)(i), and the Commission's July 23, 2024, remand order, I issued a remand initial determination in this matter. For the reasons explained in that remand initial determination and my May 15, 2024, determination, EDIS Doc. ID 816228, I have determined that a violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, has occurred in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain liquid transfer devices with an integral vial adapter that infringe claim 1 of U.S. Patent No. 10,688,295.
