
NOTICE OF INITIAL DETERMINATION ON VIOLATION OF SECTION 337

On this date, and pursuant to the Notice of Investigation, 88 Fed. Reg. 30342 (May 11, 2023), and 19 C.F.R. §§ 210.10(b), 210.42(a)(1)(i), I issued the final initial determination in this matter. As explained in that determination, I have determined that a violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, has occurred in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain liquid transfer devices with an integral vial adapter that infringe claim 1 of U.S. Patent No. 10,688,295.
