7219.31.0050: Flat rolled products of stainless steel, of a width of 600mm or more, not further worked than cold-rolled, of a thickness of 4.75mm or more not in coils

Note: Some of the Subject HTS codes did not specify whether they were coiled or not. Additionally, one of the subject HTS codes, 7219.31.00 included a non-coiled specification (7219.31.0050).
