

U.S. Copper Tubing Consumers
Increasing Mexican Production

- **October 2009:** Whirlpool announced plans to build another plant in Nuevo Leon, Mexico, and begin operations there in 2010¹
- **January 2011:** Daikin moved its Mexico City Plant to San Luis Potosi, Mexico, in order to expand its production capacity²
- **June 2011:** Rheem Manufacturing Company announced the transfer of its Gas Furnace Residential Product division to Nuevo Laredo, Mexico³
- **June 2011:** Tecumseh Products Co. announced the expansion of its distribution network in Mexico to reach eleven (11) locations throughout the country⁴
- **December 2012:** Rheem announced it would move more of its HVAC operations to Mexico⁵
- **July 2013:** Lennox International announced its plans to add a new production line for heating units at its Mexico plant⁶
- **December 2013:** Johnson controls announces plans to move production of heat exchangers to Durango, Mexico⁷
- **April 2014:** Daikin in the process of opening a new plant in San Luis Potosi, Mexico, aiming to shift the production of core components from its U.S. factory in Auburn by the end of 2015⁸
- **August, 2015:** Tecumseh Products Co. entered into a definitive agreement to be acquired by Mueller Industries⁹
- **February 2016:** Carrier Corp. announced its decision to move the company's Heating and Ventilating Parts manufacturing unit to Monterrey, Mexico¹⁰
- **August 2016:** Whirlpool announced further investment to increase the production capacity of its Mexico plants¹¹
