A. INTRODUCTION

1. Coverage. This pamphlet lists all publications issued by the Tariff Commission during the period from January 1, 1951, through April 30, 1965.

It is expected that supplemental lists will be issued annually, and cumulated at appropriate intervals.

Publications issued before 1951 are, in most cases, out of print as well as out of date. Special needs for such publications should be taken up in writing or in person with the Secretary's Office.

- 2. Depository Libraries. In many cases, the publications listed herein may be found in Federal Depository Libraries. These include leading public, university, and college libraries throughout the country. A complete list of depository libraries may be obtained from the Superintendent of Documents of the U.S. Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C. 20402.
- 3. Requests and Orders. Publications which are listed as available from the Tariff Commission may be obtained without charge as long as the supply lasts.

Publications shown as available at the U.S. Government Printing Office may be ordered from the Division of Public Documents, U.S. Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C. 20402. Orders should be accompanied by check or money order for the amount indicated. All such orders and checks should be made out to the Superintendent of Documents, not to the Tariff Commission.
