INTRODUCTION

This series of quarterly reports by the U.S. International Trade Commission is made pursuant to Title IV, section 410 of the Trade Act of 1974,¹ which requires the Commission to monitor the flow of imports and exports between the United States and certain countries.² These countries include, on the one hand, those that are accorded most-favored-nation (MFN) status under waivers of the freedom-of-emigration requirement (Jackson-Vanik amendment) of section 402 of the 1974 Trade Act, and, on the other, those that are listed in general note 3(b) of the *Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States* (HTS).³ The countries receiving MFN tariff treatment are subject to the rates of duty in the general subcolumn of column 1 of the HTS, whereas the remainder of the countries monitored by this series of reports are subject to the generally higher statutory rates of duty in column 2.⁴ The monitored countries receiving MFN tariff treatment as of yearend 1993 were Albania, Armenia, Belarus, Bulgaria, China, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Mongolia, Romania, Russia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, and Ukraine.⁵

Section 410 also requires that reports in this series present data on the effect, if any, of imports from the monitored countries on the production of like or directly competitive articles in the United States and on employment within the domestic industries producing these articles. To fulfill this requirement, the Commission developed an automated trade-monitoring system to identify imports of manufactured goods from these countries that have grown rapidly and to measure the degree of penetration of such imports. The monitoring system is run only once each year since comprehensive data on the production of the U.S. manufacturing sector are compiled and published annually rather than quarterly.

However, since a number of the countries whose trade is covered under section 410 have rejected central economic planning, the term "nonmarket economy" is no longer used in this series of reports.

China accounts for most of the U.S. trade with the monitored countries. Trade between the United States and the former Soviet Union (the sum of U.S. trade with Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Russia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, and Uzbekistan) is also relatively significant.⁶ In addition, U.S. exports to and imports from Albania, Bulgaria, Cambodia, Laos, Mongolia, and Romania are included in the totals for "all monitored countries." Tables on trade with each of these countries appear in chapters 1, 2, 3, and 4. The negligible volume of transactions reported with the countries under U.S. trade embargo (Cuba, North Korea, and Vietnam)⁷ is no longer included in the total trade figures. Tables showing the few items, if any, traded with each embargoed country can be found in chapter 5.

The trade data in this series of reports are compiled from official statistics of the U.S. Bureau of the Census. Imports are "imports for consumption," the sum of directly entered imports plus withdrawals from customs warehouses, at customs value, which is generally equivalent to f.o.b. (free on board) value at the foreign port of export. Exports are "domestic exports," U.S.-produced goods, at f.a.s. (free alongside ship) value at the U.S. port. All data in this series are presented in terms of the Harmonized System (HS). The most detailed presentation of imports is based on the six-digit subheadings of the HTS, and that of exports is based on the six-digit subheadings of the HS-based *Schedule B* (1990 edition). Aggregate trade levels and trends are presented in terms of HTS and of HS-based *Schedule B* sections, chapters (2-digit numbers), and headings (4-digit numbers).⁸

This quarterly report contains tables on U.S. trade with the monitored countries during 1993 and also includes data on trade with these countries during the fourth quarter of the year. Beginning with this report, tables 1-4, 2-3, 2-4, 2-8, and 2-9 have been added to replace and supplement data previously covered in the trade developments section of the text.

⁶ The 1991 data on U.S. trade with the former Soviet Union that appear in this report also include trade with the Baltic nations (Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania). The 1992 data do not include the Baltic nations but do include, in addition to the reported trade with each of the 12 successor states to the former Soviet Union, "unallocated" trade; i.e., trade designated as exports to or imports from the former Soviet Union rather than from a specific successor state. By the beginning of 1993, however, all U.S. trade with the former Soviet Union was completely allocated among the successor states.
