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## USITC RELEASES REPORT ON MOTOR-VEHICLE TRADE DATA

The United States International Trade Commission today announced the release of its annual statistical report on automotive trade data. This report, entitled Automotive Trade Statistics, 1964-78: U.S. Factory Sales, Imports, Exports, Apparent Consumption, and Trade Balances With Canada and All Other Countries, is the ninth annual compilation of automotive trade statistics.

The report provides information on U.S. factory sales, imports, exports, apparent consumption, and bilateral trade balances for new passenger automobiles, automobile trucks, truck chassis and cabs, motor buses, snowmobiles, miscellaneous motor vehicles, and motor-vehicle parts for the years 1964-78. Data on bilateral trade balances deal primarily with United States-Canadian trade, but aggregate U.S. trade data with other countries are also included.

Total U.S. factory sales of automobiles, trucks, and buses in 1978 amounted to 12.9 million units, surpassing the previous record set in 1977 by about 233,000 units or almost 2 percent. An increase in truck and bus sales in 1978 more than compensated for the slight decline in

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factory sales of passenger automobiles. Imports of automobiles, trucks, and buses were also at a record level in 1978, amounting to 3,363,000 units, 11 percent above the previous high in 1977.

Imports of all automotive products (vehicles, parts, accessories, and so forth) were valued at \$25.9 billion in 1978, 27 percent more than imports of such products in 1977. While U.S. exports of automotive products increased in 1978, they did not keep pace with imports, and the U.S. trade deficit in automotive products (totaling \$11.6 billion) worsened by some \$4.3 billion.

U.S. trade with Canada in automotive products also increased; imports rose from \$10.1 billion in 1977 to \$11.1 billion in 1978, and exports, from \$8.6 billion in 1977 to \$9.1 billion in 1978.

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## Preface

This is the ninth annual compilation of automotive trade statistics; the first was prepared by the United States International Trade Commission (formerly the United States Tariff Commission) in 1971 in response to an informal request from the Congress.

The material presented in these tables provides information on U.S. factory sales, imports, exports, apparent consumption, and bilateral trade balances for new passenger automobiles, automobile trucks, truck chassis and cabs, motor buses, snowmobiles, miscellaneous motor vehicles, and motor vehicle parts for the years 1964-78. The bilateral trade balances deal primarily with United States-Canadian trade, but there are also tables showing aggregate U.S. trade with other countries.

The data presented herein on imports and exports were compiled principally from official statistics of the U.S. Department of Commerce; data relating to U.S. factory sales were provided by the Motor Vehicle Manufacturers Association (automobiles, trucks, and buses) and the International Snowmobile Industry Association. Unless otherwise indicated, all annual data are for calendar years, and dollar amounts are presented in U.S. dollars, unadjusted for inflation.

## Summary

The data presented in the following tables indicate that the value of all imports of automotive products during 1978 was \$25.9 billion, and the value of U.S. exports of such articles was \$14.3 billion. Thus, the United States experienced a net trade deficit of \$11.6 billion in automotive products in 1978. This deficit represents a \$4.3-billion increase over the 1977 figure of \$7.3 billion. There has not been a surplus in trade in automotive products since 1967, when a small surplus of \$290 million was registered.

New passenger automobiles represented about 54 percent (\$14.1 billion) of total imports of automotive products in 1978; motor-vehicle parts, 37 percent (\$9.5 billion); and automobile trucks, buses, snowmobiles, and other miscellaneous motor vehicles, the remaining 9 percent (\$2.3 billion). Motor-vehicle parts accounted for 56 percent (\$8 billion) of U.S. exports in 1978; completed motor vehicles accounted for the other \$6.3 billion. Thus, most of the U.S. trade deficit in automotive products can be attributed to the importation of new passenger automobiles.

The United States imported automotive products valued at \$11.1 billion from Canada in 1978. Of this total, \$4.5 billion represented the value of new passenger automobiles; \$4.5 billion, motor-vehicle parts; \$2.0 billion, automobile trucks; and \$100 million, miscellaneous motor vehicles. U.S. exports of automotive products to Canada in 1978 totaled \$9.1 billion, about 90 percent of which consisted of new passenger automobiles and automotive parts, indicating a \$2.0-billion deficit in trade with Canada in 1978. With the exception of 1975, when the United States had a small trade surplus of \$237 million, a deficit in trade with Canada has been recorded in each year since 1967.

The deficit in this trade between the United States and all countries other than Canada (primarily Japan, West Germany, and the United Kingdom) has steadily grown since 1967. U.S. trade in automotive products with these countries has deteriorated from a \$1.7-billion surplus registered in 1964 to a \$9.5-billion deficit in 1978.
