Entities with multiple participants must obtain a separate slot for each individual in their group.

**IMPORTANT -- Registering for a slot DOES NOT constitute an official request to appear and give testimony at the hearing.**

- **Requests to appear at the public hearing** should be filed electronically no later than 5:15 p.m. on July 1, 2020, with the Secretary, U.S. International Trade Commission, 500 E Street SW, Washington, DC 20436.
- **Your request to appear at the hearing must be made through the Commission's Electronic Document Information System (<https://edis.usitc.gov>)**. No in-person paper-based filings or paper copies of any electronic filings will be accepted until further notice.
- **All witnesses must file an electronic copy of their testimony through EDIS no later than 12 p.m. (noon) on Monday, July 27, 2020.**
