ORDER DENYING REQUEST FOR EARLY ADJUDICATION OF CERTAIN ISSUES

On March 1, 2023, Complainant Serendia, LLC (“Serendia” or “Complainant”) filed a complaint. On March 16, 2023, Proposed Respondents Lutronic Corporation, Lutronic Aesthetics, Inc., AKA Lutronic, Inc., and Lutronic, LLC (collectively, “Lutronic”), Ilooda Co., Ltd. (“Ilooda”), Cutera, Inc. (“Cutera”), and Jeisys Medical Inc. (“Jeisys”) submitted requests that the Commission direct the Administrative Law Judge to make early findings regarding the economic prong of the domestic industry as plead in the complaint. EDIS Doc. ID Nos. 792623 at 4, 792624 at 5, 792632 at 5 (Mar. 16, 2023). On March 17, 2023, Complainant filed a response opposing Lutronic, Ilooda, Cutera, and Jeisys’ requests. EDIS Doc. ID No. 792728 (Mar. 17, 2023).

The Commission has determined to deny the requests and has determined not to use the Early Disposition Program pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.10(b)(3) for this investigation. The suggested economic prong analysis may be too complex to be decided within 100 days of institution. Accordingly, the Commission hereby **DENIES** Lutronic, Ilooda, Cutera, and Jeisys’ requests.
