**NOTICE OF A COMMISSION DETERMINATION NOT TO REVIEW
AN INITIAL DETERMINATION SETTING A 19-MONTH TARGET DATE**

AGENCY: U.S. International Trade Commission.

ACTION: Notice.

SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission (“Commission”) has determined not to review an initial determination (“ID”) (Order No. 5) of the presiding administrative law judge (“ALJ”), setting the target date for completion of the above-captioned investigation as July 16, 2026.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The Commission instituted this investigation on December 18, 2024, based on a complaint filed by Gavrieli Brands LLC. 89 FR 102951-53 (Dec. 18, 2024). The complaint, as supplemented, alleges violations of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. 1337, in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain women’s flats with colored outsoles thereof by reason of infringement of the claim of one or more of U.S. Design Patent Nos. D681,928, D844,950, D844,951, D681,927, D781,035, D781,032, D686,812, and D688,853. The complaint further alleges that a domestic industry exists. *Id.* at 45922. The Commission’s notice of investigation named as respondents Kijera’s OneDrop LLC of New York, New York; Craze of Essel Park, Philippines; Pierjeda Information Technology Co., Ltd. and Guangzhou Shun Cheng Trading Co., Ltd. of Guangzhou, China; Shengze Trading Company of Zhangshou City, China; Kunming Ouxiang Trading Co., Ltd. of Kunming City, China; Huihui Bianan of Beijing, China; Bingxin Qingfeng of Zhongshan City, China; Baiqiuju1983,

tb249835650, Yuyoufang Foreign Trade Store, and Xu Wengping 123 of Zhongshan City, China; and Ynwll of Huilongguan, China.

On January 24, 2025, the ALJ issued the subject ID (Order No. 5), setting the target date for completion of the investigation as July 16, 2026. No petitions for review of the ID were filed.

The Commission has determined not to review the subject ID. The target date for completion of the investigation is set to July 16, 2026, and the final initial determination on violation is due by March 16, 2026.

The Commission vote for this determination took place on February 24, 2025.

The authority for the Commission's determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. 1337), and in Part 210 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 CFR Part 210).
