**NOTICE OF COMMISSION DETERMINATION TO EXTEND THE DATE FOR  
DETERMINING WHETHER TO REVIEW THE FINAL INITIAL DETERMINATION  
ON VIOLATION TO JANUARY 23, 2013 AND THE TARGET DATE FOR  
COMPLETION OF THE INVESTIGATION TO MARCH 27, 2013**

AGENCY: U.S. International Trade Commission.

ACTION: Notice.

SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission has determined to extend the date by which it will determine whether to review the final initial determination (“ID”) on violation to January 23, 2013 and the target date for completion of this investigation to March 27, 2013.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The Commission instituted this investigation on August 5, 2011, based on a complaint filed by Apple Inc. (“Apple”) of Cupertino, California. *76 Fed. Reg.* 47610 (Aug. 5, 2011). The complaint alleges violations of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1337, in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, and the sale within the United States after importation of certain electronic digital media devices and components thereof by reason of infringement of certain claims of U.S. Patent

Nos. 7,479,949; RE 41,922; 7,863,533; 7,789,697; 7,912,501; D558,757; and D618,678. The complaint further alleges the existence of a domestic industry. The respondents named in the Commission's notice of investigation are Samsung Electronics Co, Ltd. of Korea; Samsung Electronics America, Inc. of Ridgefield Park, New Jersey; and Samsung Telecommunications America, LLC of Richardson, Texas.

On October 15, 2012, the ALJ issued an ID, extending the target date by six (6) days to February 25, 2013 (Order No. 16). The Commission determined not to review the ID and further determined to extend the date by which it would determine whether to review the final ID on violation to January 9, 2013, and to extend the target date for completion of this investigation to March 13, 2013. *See* Notice of Commission Determination Not to Review an Initial Determination Extending the Target Date by Six Days; Further Extension of the Target Date to March 13, 2013 and Extension of the Date for Determining Whether to Review the Final ID to January 9, 2013 (Nov. 7, 2012).

The ALJ issued his final ID on violation on October 25, 2012. On November 2, 2012, the Investigative Attorney requested for an extension of the deadline to file a petition for review and responses thereto for all parties. The Commission granted the request. The parties filed their petitions for review on November 8, 2012, and their respective responses on November 19, 2012.

The Commission has determined to extend the date by which it will determine whether to review the final ID on violation to January 23, 2013 and the target date for completion of this investigation to March 27, 2013.

The authority for the Commission's determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. § 1337), and in section 210.42 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 C.F.R. § 210.42).
