Re: Petition to Suspend the Remedial Orders in *Certain Network Devices, Related Software and Components Thereof (I)*, Inv. 337-TA-944.

Dear Mr. Bartkowski:

Under Commission Rule 210.76(b)(1), 19 C.F.R. § 210.76(b)(1), the Commission may extend the 30-day deadline for voting on institution when “[e]xceptional circumstances preclude adherence to a 30-day deadline.” Rule 210.76(b)(2) further provides that “[i]f exceptional circumstances preclude Commission adherence to the 30-day deadline for determining whether to institute a modification or rescission proceeding on the basis of the petition, the determination will be made as soon after that deadline as possible.”

Based on the unusual nature of this request, the Commission will need addition time to consider whether to institute a proceeding. Thus, the Commission has determined to postpone its vote on institution, and has determined that the new deadline is set for October 22, 2018.
