Due to the Department of Commerce's tolling of case deadlines by an additional 21 calendar days, the Commission is revising its schedule as follows: the additional deadline for filing supplemental briefs commenting on the Department of Commerce's final determinations is December 30, 2025; the Commission will make its final release of information on January 9, 2026; and final party comments are due on January 13, 2026.
