NOTICE REGARDING INITIAL DETERMINATION ON VIOLATION OF SECTION 337 AND RECOMMENDED DETERMINATION ON REMEDY AND BONDING

(July 13, 2015)

On this date, the ALJ issued an initial determination on violation of Section 337 and recommended determination on remedy and bond in the above-referenced investigation. It is held that no violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1337, has occurred in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain marine sonar imagining systems, products containing the same, and components thereof by reason of infringement of the asserted claims of U.S. Patent Nos. 7,652,952 and 7,710,825 and claim 25 of U.S. Patent No. 7,755,974.

It is held that a violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1337, has occurred in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain marine sonar imaging systems, products containing the same, and components thereof by reason of infringement of claims 14, 18, 21, 22,

23 and 33 of U.S. Patent No. 7,755,974.
