

NOTICE OF INITIAL DETERMINATION ON VIOLATION OF SECTION 337

(August 1, 2025)

On this date, and pursuant to the Notice of Investigation, 89 Fed. Reg. 58764 (July 19, 2024), and 19 C.F.R. §§ 210.10(b), 210.42(a)(1)(i), I issued the final initial determination in this matter. As explained in that determination, I have determined that a violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, has occurred in the importation into the United States and sale within the United States after importation of certain interlockable storage containers and toolboxes, organizers, component boxes, and coolers based on infringement of U.S. Patent No. 11,365,026, U.S. Patent No. 11,794,952, and U.S. Patent No. 11,952,167.
