

**ORDER NO. 28: NOTICE OF INITIAL DETERMINATION ON VIOLATION OF  
SECTION 337 AND RECOMMENDED DETERMINATION ON  
REMEDY AND BOND**

On this date, and pursuant to the Notice of Investigation, 89 Fed. Reg. 99905 (Dec. 11, 2024) (“Notice of Investigation”), I issued the final Initial Determination in this matter. As explained in that determination, I have determined that a violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, has occurred in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain crafting machines and components thereof that infringe certain claims of U.S. Patent No. 11,905,646, U.S. Design Patent No. D893,563, and U.S. Design Patent No. D1,029,090.
