**NOTICE OF INITIAL DETERMINATION ON VIOLATION OF SECTION 337 AND
RECOMMENDED DETERMINATION ON REMEDY AND BOND**

(April 10, 2026)

On this date, and pursuant to the Notice of Investigation, 90 Fed. Reg. 10730 (Feb. 26, 2025), and 19 C.F.R. §§ 210.10(b), 210.42(a)(1)(i), I issued the final initial determination in this matter. As explained in that determination, I have determined that a violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, has occurred in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain motorized self-balancing vehicles that infringe claims 10, 11, and 16 of U.S. Patent No. RE46,964 and claims 10-13 of U.S. Patent No. RE49,608.
