**SUMMARY:** Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission ("Commission") has determined not to review an initial determination ("ID") setting a seventeen and a half (17.5)-month target date for the completion of this investigation. The target date for this investigation is March 31, 2021, and the final ID will issue no later than November 30, 2020.

**SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION**: On October 17, 2019, the Commission instituted this investigation based on a complaint filed by Innovation Sciences LLC of Plano, Texas. 84 FR 55583. The complaint (and supplement thereto) alleges violations of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. 1337 based upon the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain wireless communication devices, and related components thereof by reason of infringement of certain claims of U.S. Patent Nos. 10,136,179 and 10,104,425. *Id.* The Commission's notice of investigation named as respondents Resideo Technologies, Inc. of Austin, Texas; HTC Corporation of Republic of China, Taiwan; and HTC America, Inc. of Seattle, Washington. *Id.* at 55584. The Office of Unfair Import Investigations was also named as a party to this investigation. *Id.* 

On October 17, 2019, the ALJ issued the subject ID, which sets a seventeen and a half (17.5)-month target date for the completion of this investigation. Accordingly, the ALJ set the target date for this investigation as March 31, 2021, and the deadline for issuing the ID as November 30, 2020. No petitions for review of the subject ID were filed.

The Commission has determined not to review the subject ID.

The authority for the Commission's determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. 1337), and in Part 210 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 CFR part 210).
