NOTICE OF A COMMISSION DETERMINATION NOT TO REVIEW AN INITIAL DETERMINATION SETTING THE TARGET DATE FOR COMPLETION OF THE INVESTIGATION

SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission has determined not to review an initial determination ("ID") (Order No. 8) of the presiding Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") setting the target date for completion of the investigation to April 22, 2024.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: On October 19, 2022, the Commission instituted this investigation under section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. 1337, based on a complaint filed by Daedalus Prime LLC of Bronxville, New York. 87 FR 63524-25 (Oct. 19, 2022). The complaint alleged a violation of section 337 in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain semiconductor devices, mobile devices containing the same, and components thereof by reason of the infringement of certain claims of U.S. Patent Nos. 9,831,306; 10,319,812; 10,700,178; and 11,251,281. The complaint also alleged the existence of a domestic industry.

The notice of investigation named as respondents Samsung Electronics Co., Ltd. of

Suwon-si, Gyeonggi-do, Republic of Korea; Samsung Electronics America, Inc. of Ridgefield Park, New Jersey; Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Company Limited of Hsinchu City, Taiwan; and TSMC North America of San Jose, California. *Id.* at 63525. The Commission's Office of Unfair Import Investigations is also named as a party in this investigation. *Id.*

On November 16, the ALJ issued the subject ID setting the target date. The ID noted that the parties to the investigation submitted a joint statement regarding scheduling and discovery on November 7, 2022. ID at 1. The ID stated that in view of the parties' positions and the ALJ's responsibilities in other investigations, the target date for this investigation is set to Monday, April 22, 2024. *Id.* at 2. The final initial determination on violation shall be due by Friday, December 22, 2023.

No party petitioned for review of the ID. The Commission has determined not to review the subject ID. Accordingly, the target date for completion of this investigation is April 22, 2024.

The Commission vote for this determination took place on December 14, 2022.

The authority for the Commission's determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. 1337, and in Part 210 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 19 CFR Part 210.
