**NOTICE OF A COMMISSION DETERMINATION NOT TO REVIEW AN INITIAL  
DETERMINATION EXTENDING THE TARGET DATE FOR COMPLETION OF THE  
INVESTIGATION**

**AGENCY:** U.S. International Trade Commission.

**ACTION:** Notice.

**SUMMARY:** Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission has determined not to review the presiding administrative law judge's ("ALJ") initial determination ("ID") (Order No. 34) extending the target date for completion of the investigation by approximately three weeks from July 22, 2024 to August 16, 2024.

**SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION:** On January 10, 2023, the Commission instituted this investigation based on a complaint filed by Samsung Electronics Co., Ltd. of the Republic of Korea; Samsung Electronics America, Inc. of Ridgefield Park, New Jersey; Samsung Research America, Inc. of Mountain View, California; and Samsung International, Inc. of Chula Vista, California. 88 FR 1404-05 (Jan. 10, 2023). The complaint alleged violations of section 337 based on the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of components for certain environmentally-protected LCD digital displays and products containing same by reason of infringement of certain claims of U.S. Patent Nos. 7,948,575; 8,111,348; RE45,117; 8,842,253; and 8,223,311. *Id.* The Commission's notice of investigation named Manufacturing Resources International of Alpharetta, Georgia as the sole respondent. The Office of Unfair Import Investigations was not named as a party in this investigation. *Id.*

On March 7, 2024, the ALJ issued an ID extending the target date for completion of this Investigation by twelve days from July 10, 2024 to July 22, 2024. *See* Order No. 33 (Mar. 7, 2024), *unreviewed by* Comm'n Notice (Mar. 25, 2024).

On March 19, 2024, the ALJ issued the subject ID (Order No. 34) extending the target date for completion of this Investigation by approximately three weeks from July 22, 2024 to August 16, 2024. The ID indicates that, under this schedule, the due date to issue the final ID on violation is April 16, 2024. No one petitioned for review of the subject ID.

The Commission has determined not to review the subject ID. The target date for completion of the investigation is extended to August 16, 2024.

The Commission vote for this determination took place on April 16, 2024.

The authority for the Commission's determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. 1337), and in Part 210 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 CFR Part 210).
