**NOTICE OF A COMMISSION DETERMINATION NOT TO REVIEW AN INITIAL
DETERMINATION FINDING CERTAIN RESPONDENTS IN DEFAULT**

ACTION: Notice.

SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission (“Commission”) has determined not to review an initial determination (“ID”) (Order No. 27) of the presiding administrative law judge (“ALJ”) finding respondents Parts4Cells Inc., DFW Imports LLC d/b/a DFW Cellphone and Parts, Gadgetfix Corp., and eTech Parts Plus, LLC in default.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: On February 3, 2023, the Commission instituted this investigation based on a complaint filed by Samsung Display Co., Ltd. (“Samsung Display”) of the Republic of Korea. 88 FR 7463-64 (Feb. 3, 2023). The complaint alleges violations of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. 1337 based upon the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or sale within the United States after importation of certain active matrix organic light-emitting diode display panels and modules for mobile devices, and components thereof by reason of the infringement of certain claims of U.S. Patent Nos. 9,818,803; 10,854,683; 7,414,599; and 9,330,593. *Id.* The Commission’s notice of investigation named numerous respondents including Parts4Cells Inc. of Houston, Texas, DFW Imports LLC d/b/a DFW Cellphone and Parts of Dallas, Texas, Gadgetfix Corp. of Irvine,

California, and eTech Parts Plus, LLC Southlake, Texas. *Id.* The Office of Unfair Import Investigations was also named as a party in this investigation. *Id.*

On July 26, 2023, Respondent Parts4Cells Inc. filed a Notice of Intent to Default. On July 28, 2023, Respondents DFW Imports LLC d/b/a DFW Cellphone and Parts and Gadgetfix Corp. each filed a Notice of Intent to Default. On July 31, 2023, Respondent eTech Parts Plus, LLC filed a Notice of Intent to Default.

On August 8, 2023, the ALJ issued the subject ID (Order No. 27) finding Respondents Parts4Cells Inc., DFW Imports LLC d/b/a DFW Cellphone and Parts, Gadgetfix Corp., and eTech Parts Plus, LLC in default. No petitions for review of the ID were filed.

The Commission has determined not to review the subject ID. Respondents Parts4Cells Inc., DFW Imports LLC d/b/a DFW Cellphone and Parts, Gadgetfix Corp., and eTech Parts Plus, LLC have been found in default.

The Commission vote for this determination took place on August 30, 2023.

The authority for the Commission's determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. 1337), and in Part 210 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 CFR Part 210).
