**NOTICE OF A COMMISSION DETERMINATION NOT TO REVIEW AN INITIAL
DETERMINATION SETTING A 21-MONTH TARGET DATE**

AGENCY: U.S. International Trade Commission.

ACTION: Notice.

SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission has determined not to review an initial determination (“ID”) (Order No. 9) of the presiding administrative law judge (“ALJ”) setting a 21-month target date of December 6, 2027.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The Commission instituted this investigation on March 6, 2026, based on a complaint filed by AX Wireless, LLC of Austin, Texas. 91 FR 11086-87 (Mar. 6, 2026). The complaint, as supplemented, alleges violations of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. 1337 (“section 337”), based upon the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, and the sale within the United States after importation of certain laptops, routers and gateways, and components thereof by reason of the infringement of certain claims of U.S. Patent Nos. 10,079,707; 10,917,272; 11,646,927; 11,777,776; and 12,063,134. *Id.* at 11086. The complaint further alleges that a domestic industry exists. *Id.* The notice of investigation names as respondents ASUSTeK Computer Inc. (Taiwan) of Taipei, Taiwan; ASUS Computer International, Inc. of Fremont, California; TP-Link Systems Inc. of Irvine, California; D-Link Corporation of Taipei, Taiwan; D-Link Systems, Inc. of Irvine, California; and Ubiquiti Inc. of New York, New York. *Id.* at 11086-87. The Office of Unfair Import Investigations is also a party in this investigation. *Id.* at 11087.

On March 26, 2026, the ALJ issued the subject ID (Order No. 9) setting a 21-month target date of December 6, 2027. The subject ID states that any final ID will issue by August 6, 2027.

No petitions for review of the subject ID were filed.

The Commission has determined not to review the subject ID. The target date for completion of the investigation is set for December 6, 2027.

The Commission vote for this determination took place on April 15, 2026.

The authority for the Commission's determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. 1337), and in Part 210 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 CFR Part 210).
