**NOTICE OF A COMMISSION DETERMINATION NOT TO
REVIEW INITIAL DETERMINATION SETTING TARGET DATE**

AGENCY: U.S. International Trade Commission.

ACTION: Notice.

SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission (“Commission”) has determined not to review an initial determination (“ID”) (Order No. 4) issued by the presiding administrative law judge (“ALJ”) setting the target date for completion of this investigation as October 6, 2027.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: On April 6, 2026, the Commission instituted this investigation under section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. 1337 (“section 337”), based on a complaint filed on behalf of InnoTV Labs, LLC of Las Vegas, NV (“Complainant”). 91 FR 17305-06 (Apr. 6, 2026). The complaint alleges violations of section 337 based upon the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, and the sale within the United States after importation of certain display devices, streaming players, and components thereof by reason of the infringement of certain claims of U.S. Patent Nos. 7,965,918; 12,096,066; 10,018,863; RE50,251; 11,714,306; and 12,038,636. *Id.* The Commission’s notice of investigation (“NOI”) named the following entities as respondents: Hisense Co., Ltd. of Qingdao, China; Hisense International Co., Ltd. of Qingdao, China; Hisense Visual Technology Co., Ltd. of Qingdao, China; Hisense USA Corporation of Suwanee, GA; Hisense Electronics Manufacturing Company of America Corporation of Suwanee, GA; Hisense Monterrey Home Appliance Manufacturing, S. de R.L. de C.V. of Neuvo Leon, Mexico; Roku,

Inc. of San Jose, CA; Purple Tag Media Technology (Shanghai) Ltd. of Shanghai, China; Purple Tag Media Technology (Shanghai) Ltd.—Shenzhen Branch of Guangdong, China; and Purple Tag Mexico, S.A. de C.V. of Ciudad de México, Mexico. *Id.*

On April 16, 2026, the ALJ issued the subject ID (Order No. 4), pursuant to Commission Rule 210.51(a) (19 CFR 210.51(a)), setting the target date for completion of this investigation as October 6, 2027, which is eighteen months from the date that the NOI was published in the *Federal Register*. ID at 2. The ID explains that this target date is necessary “[b]ased upon a review of the Complaint and the NOI, and taking into account my commitments in other instituted investigations” *Id.* Under this schedule, the final ID on violation is due June 4, 2027. *Id.*


No petition for review of the subject ID was filed.

The Commission has determined not to review the subject ID. The target date for this investigation is October 6, 2027.

The Commission vote for this determination took place on May 5, 2026.

The authority for the Commission’s determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. 1337), and in Part 210 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 CFR Part 210).
