AN INITIAL DETERMINATION SETTING THE TARGET DATE**

**SUMMARY:** Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission has determined not to review the presiding administrative law judge's ("ALJ") initial determination ("ID") (Order No. 4) setting the target date for completion of the above-captioned investigation to January 13, 2028.

**SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION:** The Commission instituted this investigation on April 13, 2026, based on a complaint filed on behalf of Belkin International, Inc. of El Segundo, CA. 91 FR 18,878-879 (Apr. 13, 2026). The complaint, as supplemented, alleges violations of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. 1337, in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, and the sale within the United States after importation of certain screen protectors, application systems for use therewith, and components thereof by reason of infringement of claims 1-19 of U.S. Patent No. 10,675,817, claims 1-20 of U.S. Patent No. 10,782,746, and claims 1-18 of U.S. Patent No. 11,772,320. The complaint further alleges that an industry in the United States exists as required by the applicable Federal Statute. The Commission's notice of investigation names Superior Communications, Inc. of Irwindale, CA, as respondent. *Id.* at 59,580. The Office of Unfair Import Investigations is not named as a party in this investigation.

On May 8, 2026, the ALJ issued the subject ID (Order No. 4), setting the target date for completion of the investigation to January 13, 2028. Based on this target date, the deadline for issuing the final ID is September 13, 2027. No petitions for review were filed.

The Commission has determined not to review the subject ID. The target date is set for January 13, 2028.

The Commission vote for this determination took place on May 22, 2026.

The authority for the Commission's determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. 1337, and in Part 210 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 19 CFR Part 210.
