**NOTICE OF A COMMISSION DETERMINATION NOT TO REVIEW
AN INITIAL DETERMINATION SETTING A SEVENTEEN-MONTH TARGET DATE**

AGENCY: U.S. International Trade Commission.

ACTION: Notice.

SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission (“Commission”) has determined not to review an initial determination (“ID”) (Order No. 5) of the presiding administrative law judge (“ALJ”), setting a 17-month target date for completion of the above-captioned investigation.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The Commission instituted this investigation on July 27, 2026, based on a complaint filed by The Ergo Baby Carrier, Inc. of Torrance, California. 91 Fed. Reg. 46944-45 (July 27, 2026). The complaint, as supplemented, alleges violations of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. 1337, in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain adjustable child carriers and components thereof by reason of infringement of claims 1-3, 5, 6, 12, 16, and 17 of U.S. Patent No. 10,426,275 and claims 1, 6-11, 17, 18, and 22-25 of U.S. Patent No. 12,016,470. *Id.* at 46945. The Commission’s notice of investigation named the following respondents: Mabe, LLC of Shelley, Idaho; Quanzhou Baby Nice Infant and Child Products Co., Ltd. of Quanzhou City, China; Xiamen Funwhale Technology LLC and Xiamen New Baby Products Co., Ltd. of Xiamen City, China; Koi Trading Services of Diamond Bar, California; Portier USA, LLC of Sheridan, Wyoming; Ava + Oliver, LLC of Honolulu, Hawaii;

Artipoppe B.V. of Lexmond, The Netherlands; Bugaboo Xiamen Industrial Co. Ltd. of Xiamen, China; Bugaboo International B.V. of Amsterdam, The Netherlands; and Bugaboo North America, Inc. of New York, New York. *Id.* The complaint further alleges that a domestic industry exists. *Id.* The Office of Unfair Import Investigations is not participating in the investigation. *See id.*

On August 5, 2026, the ALJ issued the subject ID (Order No. 5), setting a 17-month target date of December 27, 2027, for completion of the investigation based on her responsibilities in other investigations. Order No. 5 at 1 (Aug. 5, 2026). No petitions for review of the subject ID were filed.

The Commission has determined not to review the subject ID. The target date for completion of the investigation is December 27, 2027,¹ and the final initial determination is due on August 27, 2027.

The Commission vote for this determination took place on September 1, 2026.

The authority for the Commission's determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. 1337), and in Part 210 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 CFR Part 210).
