**NOTICE OF COMMISSION DECISION NOT TO REVIEW THREE
INITIAL DETERMINATIONS TERMINATING THE INVESTIGATION
AS TO SIX RESPONDENTS ON THE BASIS OF SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT OR WITHDRAWAL OF THE COMPLAINT**

AGENCY: U.S. International Trade Commission.

ACTION: Notice.

SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission has determined not to review the presiding administrative law judge's ("ALJ") initial determinations ("IDs") (Order Nos. 38-40) terminating the above-captioned investigation as to two respondents on the basis of a settlement agreement (Order No. 38) and as to four respondents on the basis of withdrawal of the complaint (Order Nos. 39-40).

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The Commission instituted this investigation on January 11, 2012, based on a complaint filed by Walker Digital LLC of Stamford, Connecticut ("Walker"), alleging a violation of section 337 by reason of the infringement of certain claims of U.S. Patent No. 6,263,505. *77 Fed. Reg.* 1725 (Jan. 11, 2012). The notice of institution named thirty-five respondents. Most respondents have already been terminated from the investigation.

On November 15, 2012, Walker and respondents Panasonic Corporation of Osaka, Japan, and Panasonic Corporation of North America, of Secaucus, New Jersey (collectively, “Panasonic”) moved to terminate the investigation as to Panasonic on the basis of a settlement agreement. On November 26, 2012, the Commission investigative attorney (“IA”) responded in support of the motion. On December 10, 2012, the ALJ granted the motion as an ID. Order No. 38, at 2. The ALJ determined that termination as to Panasonic is in the public interest. *Id.*; *see* 19 C.F.R. § 210.50(b)(2).

On October 18, 2012, Walker moved to terminate the investigation as to respondents Funai Electric Co., Ltd. of Osaka, Japan, Funai Corporation, Inc. of Rutherford, New Jersey, and P&F USA, Inc. of Alpharetta, Georgia (collectively, “Funai”) based upon withdrawal of the complaint against Funai. On October 31, 2012, the IA responded in support of the motion. On December 10, 2012, the ALJ granted the motion as an ID. Order No. 39, at 1.

On October 26, 2012, Walker moved to terminate the investigation with respect to respondent VIZIO, Inc. of Irvine, California (“VIZIO”) based upon withdrawal of the complaint against VIZIO. On November 7, 2012, the IA responded in support of the motion. On December 10, 2012, the ALJ granted the motion as an ID. Order No. 40, at 2.

No petitions for review of the IDs were filed. The Commission has determined not to review the IDs.

The authority for the Commission’s determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. § 1337), and in sections 210.21 and 210.42 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 C.F.R. §§ 210.21, 210.42).
