On February 18, 2000, the President pursuant to 8 Section 203 of the Trade Act of 1974, issued a proclamation 9 to facilitate positive adjustment to competition from 10 imports of Certain Circular Welded Carbon Quality Line Pipe, 11 imposed import relief for a period of three years in one 12 13 day, effective March 1, 2000. On March 1, 2003, the import relief terminated. 14 Following termination, the Commission is required by Section 15 204D of the Act, instituted Investigation No. TA-204-10, to 16 17 evaluate the effectiveness of the action in facilitating positive adjustment by the domestic line pipe industry to 18 19 import competition.
