EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATION OF ADEQUACY

Inv. Nos. 701-TA-465 and 731-TA-1161 (Second Review)

On January 4, 2021, the Commission determined to conduct expedited reviews in the subject five-year reviews pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B).

The Commission received a joint response to its notice of institution from Nucor Grating; IKG USA, LLC; Ohio Gratings, Inc.; Interstate Gratings, LLC; and Lichtgitter USA Inc., domestic producers of steel grating. The Commission found the response of each of these firms to be individually adequate. Because the Commission received adequate responses from domestic interested parties accounting for a substantial share of domestic production of steel grating in 2019, the Commission determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate.

No respondent interested party filed a response to the notice of institution. Consequently, the Commission also determined that the respondent interested party group response was inadequate.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting full reviews. It therefore determined to conduct expedited reviews of the orders.
