EXPLANATION OF COMMISSON DETERMINATIONS ON ADEQUACY

in

Circular Welded Carbon-Quality Steel Pipe from China Inv. Nos. 701-TA-447 and 731-TA-1116 (Second Review)

On March 11, 2019, the Commission determined to conduct expedited reviews in the above-referenced proceedings pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(5)).

The Commission received a joint response to the notice of institution filed on behalf of Bull Moose Tube Co.; EXLTUBE; Independence Tube Corp., a Nucor company; Southland Tube, Inc., a Nucor company; TMK IPSCO; Wheatland Tube Co.; and Zekelman Industries, all domestic producers of circular welded carbon-quality steel pipe (collectively, the "domestic interested parties"). The Commission found that each of the domestic interested parties filed an individually adequate response. Because the domestic interested parties accounted for a substantial majority of domestic production of circular welded carbon-quality steel pipe in 2017, the Commission determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate.

The Commission did not receive a response to the notice of institution from any respondent interested party. The Commission therefore determined that the respondent interested party group response was inadequate.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting full reviews. The Commission therefore determined to conduct expedited reviews of these orders.
