EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATION ON ADEQUACY

Hand Trucks and Certain Parts Thereof from China Inv. No. 731-TA-1059 (Third Review)

On October 5, 2020, the Commission determined to conduct an expedited review in the subject five-year review pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. §1675(c)(3)(B).

The Commission received a joint response to its notice of institution from Gleason Industrial Products, Inc. and Precision Products, Inc. (collectively, "domestic interested parties"), domestic producers of hand trucks and certain parts thereof ("hand trucks"). The Commission found the responses on behalf of the domestic producers to be individually adequate. Because the domestic interested parties accounted for a substantial share of domestic production of hand trucks, the Commission further determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate.

The Commission received no response to the notice of institution from any respondent interested party. Consequently, the Commission determined that the respondent interested party group response was inadequate.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting a full review. The Commission thus determined to conduct an expedited review of the order.¹
