

EXPLANATION OF COMMISSON DETERMINATION ON ADEQUACY

in

Phosphor Copper from South Korea

Inv. No. 731-TA-1314 (Review)

On June 6, 2022, the Commission determined to conduct an expedited review in the referenced proceeding pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B)).

The Commission received a response to the notice of institution from Metallurgical Products Company (“Metallurgical Products”), a domestic producer of phosphor copper. The Commission found Metallurgical Products’ response to be individually adequate. Because Metallurgical Products accounted for a substantial percentage of domestic phosphor copper production in 2021, the Commission determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate.

The Commission did not receive a response to the notice of institution from any respondent interested party. The Commission therefore determined that the respondent interested party group response was inadequate.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting a full review. The Commission therefore determined to conduct an expedited review of this order.
