

EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATIONS ON ADEQUACY

in

High Pressure Steel Cylinders from China
Inv. Nos. 701-TA-480 and 731-TA-1188 (Review)

On August 4, 2017, the Commission unanimously determined to conduct expedited reviews in the subject five-year reviews pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B).

The Commission received a response to the notice of institution from Norris Cylinder Company (“Norris”), a domestic producer of high pressure steel cylinders. The Commission found this response to be individually adequate. Because Norris is the only domestic producer of high pressure steel cylinders, the Commission determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate.

The Commission did not receive any response to the notice of institution from any respondent interested party. Consequently, the Commission determined that the respondent interested party group response was inadequate.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting full reviews and determined to conduct expedited reviews of the orders.
