**Nature of bill:** Temporary duty suspension through December 31, 2008.

**Suggested article description(s) for enactment (including appropriate HTS subheading(s)):**

3-Chloropivaloyl chloride (CAS No. 4300-97-4) (provided for in subheading 2915.90.50)

**Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:**

3-Chloropivaloyl chloride, a synthetic organic chemical, is used as an intermediate in the production of various downstream products, including photographic developers, agrochemicals, and rubber chemicals. It is also used as an initiator in the production of vinyl chloride-propylene copolymers. The proponent imports the chemical from China and uses it as an intermediate in the production of clomazone, an herbicide applied to crops such as soybeans, rice and cotton.

To suspend temporarily the duty on Chloropivaloyl Chloride.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CHLOROPIVALOYL CHLORIDE.**

4        (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:
