Phenyl isocyanate (CAS No. 103-71-9) (provided for in subheading 2929.10.80).

This synthetic organic chemical is used as a raw material for a number of specialty chemicals, such as dyes, pesticides, and specialty epoxy resins for high performance applications, like specialty adhesives. This product is imported from Germany, and is also available from China.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MONDUR P.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Heading 9902.02.14 of the Har-  
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
6 Mondur P) is amended by striking “12/31/2006” and in-  
7 serting “12/31/2009”.

8 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
9 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of enactment of this Act.
