N,N-Dimethylpiperidinium chloride is a synthetic organic chemical used as the active ingredient in a plant growth regulator for cotton. The product is imported from China.

³ The Commission may express an opinion on the HTS classification of a product to facilitate consideration of the bill. However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.

A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on N,N-dimethylpiperidinium chloride.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. N,N-DIMETHYLPYPERIDINIUM CHLORIDE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.05.70	N,N-dimethylpiperidinium chloride (CAS No. 24307-26-4) provided for in sub-heading 2933.39.250)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2008	”.
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1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of enactment of this Act.

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
