**Nature of bill:** Temporary duty suspension through December 31, 2011.

Diphosphoric acid, polymers with ethoxylated reduced methyl esters of reduced polymerized oxidized tetrafluoroethylene (CAS No. 200013-65-6) (provided for in subheading 3402.90.50).

**Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:**

The subject product is a synthetic organic chemical that is used as a surface treatment for energy reduction. It is typically used in formulated products for paper treatment to improve water, oil, and grease repellence, as well as anti-adhesion applications. Solvay Solexis imports the product from Italy.

## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on Diphosphoric acid, polymers with ethoxylated reduced methyl esters of reduced polymerized oxidized tetrafluoroethylene.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DIPHOSPHORIC ACID, POLYMERS WITH**  
4 **ETHOXYLATED REDUCED METHYL ESTERS**  
5 **OF REDUCED POLYMERIZED OXIDIZED**  
6 **TETRAFLUOROETHYLENE.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
8 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is

1 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
 2 new heading:
