The subject product is a synthetic organic chemical that is used as an intermediate to manufacture an herbicide that is used for pre-planting or pre-emergent application to control annual grasses and broad-leaved weeds in non-crop land, ornamentals, turf, conifer, and hardwood seedlings. The product is imported from Switzerland.

However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.
